Here's a Breakdown of What You Need to Do to Get Your Team Into an IM League This Season.

Form a Team.

Gather Up Friends (FSU Students) to Be on Your Team. It's FREE to Play! Fall Basketball & Soccer are 3-on-3 with Men's & Women's Leagues Available. Kickball is 8-on-8 with Men's, Women's, and Co-Rec (4 Males & 4 Females) Play. Additional Substitutes are Recommended. Players Can Only Be on 1 Men's or Women's Team & 1 Co-Rec Team. No In-Season Team Changes are Permitted.

Choose a League.

Men's, Women's, & Co-Rec (Kickball Only) Leagues are Offered. Different Divisions are Available with Division I for Talented Teams and Division II for Less Talented, Recreational Teams (the Not-So-Talented). Fall Basketball & Soccer Include 4 Regular Season Games Over 2 Weeks of Play. Kickball Teams Receive 2 Regular Season Games Over 2 Weeks of Play. All 3 Sports Then Have a Single-Elimination Postseason Playoff Tournament.

Pick a Playing Day & Time.

3-on-3 Basketball Plays Sunday through Wednesday Nights. 3-on-3 Soccer on Tuesdays through Thursdays. And, Kickball Sundays through Thursdays. Games are 30-45 Minutes Each and Take Place Between 7:00 and 11:00 pm. Teams Select Their Playing Day During Registration.

Get Your Team Registered.

Just One Person Needs to Register the Team (Have a Good Team Name!). Registration Starts the Week of October 24-28. Register Early for the Best Choices. Get the Exact Dates for Each Sport at fsu.campusrec.com/im

Take the Online Captains Exam.

Here are the Keys to Make Sure Things Run Smoothly for Your Team During the Season.

Check Your Regular Season Schedule.

Visit the IM Web Site at fsu.campusrec.com/im to Check Your Team's Regular Season Schedule for Opponents and Special Playing Dates or Times. Wait List Teams Will Receive Information from the IM Office Separately.

Inform Your Teammates & Come Out to Play!

Pass Along the Key Information to Your Teammates. In Addition to When Your Games are Scheduled, Remind Players to Arrive at Least 10 Minutes Prior to Game Time to Check-In. Each Player Needs His/Her FSUCard. All Players Must Check-In Prior to Each Game (For Doubleheaders, Simply Check-In Before Your First Game of the Night). Basketball is Played in Tully Gym. Soccer & Kickball Take Place at the Rec SportsPlex. And, Review the Key Sport Rules with Your Teammates.

Avoid a Fine.

Can't Make a Scheduled Game? Be Sure to Notify the IM Sports Office by 12 Noon on the Day of the Game. The IM Office is Not Open Weekends, So for Sunday Games, Be Sure to Contact the IM Staff by 12 Noon on Friday. Call 850-644-2430 or Email Us from Our Web Site for a FREE Default. Forfeits Result in \$20 Fine for the Captain!

Keep Your Sportsmanship Up.

Sportsmanship Matters! Make Sure Your Team Maintains a 3.0 Sportsmanship Average (on a Scale of 0-4) Throughout the Season.

Check Your Playoff Schedule.

All Teams, Regardless of Record & with the 3.0 Sportsmanship Average, are Scheduled for the Playoffs. Teams May Be Shifted Between Divisions Based on Regular Season Performance. Teams Will Be Scheduled on the Same Day as Their Regular Season Games for the Opening Round of the Tournament. Brackets are Available Online During the Last Week of the Regular Season.
