

Graduate Assistant for Intramural Sports - Position Available August 2010 through May 2012

Florida State University is seeking a dynamic individual with excellent time management skills to serve as Graduate Assistant for Intramural Sports.

The Graduate Assistant for Intramural Sports assists in the hiring, training, scheduling, and evaluating of student sports officials, scorekeepers, and sign-in staff for all intramural sports and activities. In addition, the Graduate Assistant assists the IM Director and Assistant Director with the coordinating and scheduling of intramural activities and special events.

Other responsibilities include assisting with sport registration, team captain meetings, and playoff draw meetings; attending weekly program and departmental staff meetings; assisting the Director and Assistant Director in the training, scheduling, and evaluating of student site supervisors; serving as the liaison between student and professional staff; overseeing payroll entry for student staff; reviewing participant eligibility; administering annual team championship standings for independent teams and greek organizations; assisting in the maintenance of the program web site; and preparing and distributing marketing materials to inform the student body of upcoming activities.

Position Specifics

Florida State University employs two graduate assistants for Intramural Sports, affording the GAs an intensive experience in all aspects of the program. The Intramural Sports Graduate Assistant position is a 2-year appointment: August-July (year 1) and August-April (year 2), with extension into the second summer as necessary.

Stipend and Waiver

Annual stipend of approximately \$12,000. Tuition waiver available for in-state and out-of-state residents (out-of-state residents must become in-state by start of 2nd year). Recipient is responsible for student fees each semester. Per University policy, health insurance is required of all incoming students.

Education

Bachelor's degree required. Applicant must have a 3.0 GPA and a 1000 GRE score to be considered for admission to the majority of FSU graduate programs and to qualify for the Intramural Sports tuition waiver. Please DO NOT apply if you do not meet the minimum academic requirements, unless you have already been admitted to an FSU graduate program.

Experience

Applicants should have previous experience as a student site supervisor or program assistant for a collegiate intramural sports program. Officiating background in multiple sports preferred.

Skills

Applicants must be highly organized with effective time management skills. Must possess proficient computer skills as well as strong oral and written communication skills.

Application Process - Begins February 2010

Submit letter of application, resume, and a list of at least three references. Resumes received by Friday, April 9th will be reviewed with selected candidates scheduled for phone interviews or in-person interviews at the NIRSA National Conference in Anaheim, California.
